Narrative

1. On November 20, 2022, I, Detective Andy Hodl of the Idaho State Police received phone tip number 391 and conducted follow up. The tip stated that [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1969) had called in and reported that an intruder had entered her [REDACTED] house in Pullman, Washington in October of 2021 with a knife and wearing a mask. The tip referenced Pullman Police case number [REDACTED]. Attached to tip 391 was email tip 73. This tip was from [REDACTED] and referenced the same case number.
2. At 1550 hours, I, along with ISP Detective Hugh Powell, conducted an interview with [REDACTED] over the phone. I originally called [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] which was the phone number from the tip. She called me back from [REDACTED].
3. [REDACTED] said that her [REDACTED] who was later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/2001), lived in Pullman, Washington just off of the Washington State University Campus in a house with two units in it. The address of this residence was [REDACTED], Pullman, Washington. One night, [REDACTED] left to pick up a friend at around 0230 hours. When they got home, they noticed their back door was open and their roommates had locked themselves in a bedroom. One roommate said she woke up to a male wearing a mask holding a knife standing over her. She kicked him and he fell backwards then ran out of the house. [REDACTED] said the police responded, then eventually questioned the male who lived in the second unit of the house, but he was never charged. [REDACTED] would not tell me the name of the victim but told me the victim's mother's name is [REDACTED] and gave me her phone number [REDACTED].
4. [REDACTED] then gave [REDACTED] the phone. [REDACTED] said all of the girls that lived with her were members of a sorority and she was a junior during last school year. [REDACTED] said that the neighbor who was questioned did not cause any problems prior to or after this incident. [REDACTED] said she is living in the same house this year and has not seen the neighbor since March 2022 when his lease was not renewed. [REDACTED] said she did not associate with any of the sororities at University of Idaho and did not know any of the individuals who were killed. [REDACTED] said she had parked her car outside the back door and had left it unlocked when she left to pick up her friend who was nearby. She said the door was normally locked other than when one of the residents was making a quick trip away from the house.
5. At approximately 1611 hours, Detective Powell and I contacted [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1963) by phone at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me her daughter's name is [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/2001) and gave me her phone number [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me she had called Moscow Police on November 16, 2022, and the Pullman Police Department on November 17, 2022. She was told they could not initially find the report then later told her it had been sent to Moscow Police. [REDACTED] told me Officer Banks was the investigating officer who communicated with her and [REDACTED] during their investigation.
6. I received a copy of the Pullman Police report, and the suspect was identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1981).
7. At approximately 1657 hours, ISP Detective Cody Herman and I contacted [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said the night of October 9, 2021, she had gone to bed early because she had to work early. At approximately 0300 hours on October 10, 2021, she heard her bedroom door open. She said she rolled over and saw a male walking into her room wearing a ski mask and holding a knife. [REDACTED] said she turned on her bed and kicked the male hard enough to knock him back to the wall. She said the male stared at her for a few seconds before running

up the stairs and out of the house. ■■■ said she was completely sober and aware of what had happened. ■■■ said one of her roommates was home but was watching TV loudly and did not hear anything. ■■■ had unenrolled from Washington State University and was just working, and she was no longer a member of any sororities. ■■■ described the male as smaller and very short, she estimated 5'4 to 5'6. Due to the mask, she could not see his face at all. The male did not say anything to her. ■■■ described the second unit of the house as a small studio apartment that occupied half of the basement and has a separate exterior staircase and entrance. ■■■ was the male who lived in that apartment and matched the description, but police did not talk to him until a few days later. Pullman Police eventually interviewed ■■■ but he was never charged. ■■■ said where ■■■ smoked was right outside her bedroom window and she felt he might have been able to look into her bedroom. ■■■ said she and her roommates never had any issues with ■■■ other than he was sort of awkward sometimes, but nothing really concerned them until this incident. ■■■ said she never went to parties in Moscow and did not know any of the victims in this case.

8. All of these interviews were digitally recorded. The recordings were saved to a thumb drive and turned over to the Moscow Police Department.

9. At approximately 2300 hours, I spoke to Pullman Police Officer Banks about this incident. Officer Banks said that ■■■ was the only suspect because he matched the description and had a prior incident in 2017 where a female woke up to him watching her sleep. ■■■ did not have a mask on or a weapon at that time. Officer Banks said a search warrant was conducted at ■■■ residence after the incident with ■■■ but no evidence was recovered linking him to the incident.

10. All of this information was turned over to the case agent for further review.

11. The investigation continues.
