Video collection and tips, D. Vargas MPD 124:

TIPS PROVIDED:

On November 17, 2022, Det. Chris Engle with PPD provided me with an e-mail, with information regarding several Pullman Home-Invasions involving a possible suspect of J [REDACTED] A [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). I forwarded this e-mail to the FBI/Moscow tipline to be assigned and followed up with.

On December 13, 2022, I saw an article online of the recent arrest of S [REDACTED] H [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. H [REDACTED] was arrested for stabbing multiple people at a casino in [REDACTED] and fled the area in a white sedan. I reached out and spoke with Det. M [REDACTED] A [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] County SO. Det. A [REDACTED] provided me with the description of the suspect vehicle and the weapon which was used in this offense.

Det. A [REDACTED] also stated the sheath for the knife was located on the passenger seat of the suspect vehicle. I determined this person was not involved in our incident and told Det. A [REDACTED] I would not need any further information regarding their incident.

Around December 15, 2022, I received a phone call from Det. F [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Office with information on an abandoned 2016 white Hyundai Elantra which was located in [REDACTED] County near a residence. I called Det. F [REDACTED] back and he provided me with the plate: [REDACTED], which is registered to C [REDACTED] C [REDACTED], out of [REDACTED]. Det. F [REDACTED] stated there was a past contact at the residence where this vehicle was seen parked involving a relative of C [REDACTED], E [REDACTED] F [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] and R [REDACTED] I [REDACTED] S [REDACTED]. Det. F [REDACTED] sent me a photo of the vehicle which I determined did not match the suspect vehicle description. Sgt. Blaker also had received this tip from Det. F [REDACTED] and spoke with him.

VIDEO OBTAINED AND DOWNLOADED TO MPD EVIDENCE:

On November 15, 2022, I called K [REDACTED] F [REDACTED], the property owner for [REDACTED] Linda Ln. and asked about video footage he has on the property. F [REDACTED] stated he did have video and later sent me an e-mail with a direct login to his

camera system so the videos could be viewed for any time frame. Details of the e-mail are below:

R [REDACTED] and D [REDACTED], below is a link to a google drive with footage from our cameras at [REDACTED] Linda Ln. I uploaded videos from two cameras from 0200 through 0600 on 11/13. One camera shows the parking lot of [REDACTED] including a little bit of the parking lot from the Queen apartments below. The other camera covers the street of Linda Ln looking toward Taylor/Blake.

The longer videos (larger files) show an entire hour, while the shorter videos show clips where the camera/system detected motion.

The videos are currently uploading, so keep refreshing if they are not all there.

Additionally, I am providing a login to the camera system so that you can review any of the cameras for any timeframe.

Once logged in you can choose any of the four cameras from the list on the right (if using a PC). You can click on the Playback tab at the top, and then the date from the calendar on the right. Then use the timeline at the bottom to select when to view.

Note that the camera that points down Linda Ln goes offline every day from [REDACTED] for a scheduled wifi reset.

In addition to using a web browser to view the videos, there is a PC app and a mobile app that can be downloaded and installed. Just search for [REDACTED]. You can use the same IP address as in the URL above, along with the [REDACTED], when configuring the app.

I forwarded this information to FBI R [REDACTED] H [REDACTED] on how to access the Linda Ln. video.

On November 27, 2022, I called C [REDACTED] F [REDACTED], who lives at [REDACTED] Dr. I asked F [REDACTED] if she still had her Nest Camera system and she stated she did. F [REDACTED] put me in contact with her husband, B [REDACTED] B [REDACTED], and said he could provide me with their available camera footage. B [REDACTED] brought a hard

drive to MPD which contained video footage from their Nest cameras. A white sedan, matching the description of the suspect vehicle, is seen traveling west on Indian Hills Dr. and passes by [REDACTED] Indian Hills Dr. on 11-13-2022 at approximately 0325 hours.

Around the end of November and the beginning of December 2022, Det. Chris Engle, PPD, provided me with the following videos from several Pullman businesses:



On December 2, 2022, Det. Chris Engle provided me with the contact information for the [REDACTED], [REDACTED] Pullman, WA. I reached out to the Corporate Security Head, M [REDACTED] G [REDACTED], and he stated we could come to the branch in Pullman and view the video on site to see if it would be of any evidentiary value, prior to requesting a search warrant to obtain the video. FBI R [REDACTED] E [REDACTED] made arrangements to view the available video at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. FBI R [REDACTED] called me and told me he viewed the available video and did not locate anything of evidentiary value.

On January 3, 2023, K [REDACTED] I [REDACTED], Pullman PD Records Specialist, sent me a link to PPD evidence.com and shared all videos and photos for two PPD cases, [REDACTED] and D [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was a found Buck Knife in a sheath located on Terre View in front of the WSU Technology Research Park on 12-29-2022. The photos for this case are attached in Spillman to the original call and I did not download the photos from PPD evidence.com. [REDACTED] was a hit and run/DUI accident at [REDACTED] which occurred 11-12-2022 at approximately 2340 hours. This location is on the same road leading to Kohberger's apartment complex. Multiple officers responded to this location and remained on scene for several hours with their in car cameras and body cameras capturing video. The videos span from 11-12-2022 at 2341 hours to 11-13-2022 at 0325 hours. The suspect vehicle was located on WSU Greek Row and officers responded to that location as well. C [REDACTED] E. F [REDACTED], the owner of the suspect vehicle, was contacted and arrested for this offense and booked into the Whitman County Jail. While reviewing the photos located on Kohberger's phone, I found a screen shot of F [REDACTED] Whitman County booking information taken from the Whitman County Jail Roster, last modified date, 11-13-2022 at 06:27 PM. I downloaded all of the videos from PPD evidence.com, regarding [REDACTED], and will review to see if Kohberger drove by the incident between 2341 to 0325 hours.
