**Narrative**

1. On November 17, 2022, I interviewed [REDACTED] by telephone (phone) regarding his purchase of a [REDACTED] from Goncalves on November 12, 2022. [REDACTED] provided the following information:
- A. He located the [REDACTED] on Facebook marketplace.
  - B. After corresponding with Goncalves via Facebook messenger and agreeing on the sale price of \$6,500.00, he met her in the Hayden, Idaho Wal-Mart parking lot around 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. on November 12, 2022.
  - C. Goncalves arrived in the [REDACTED], and her father arrived a short time later. After a test drive, he handed Goncalves the \$6,500.00 cash and completed the deal.
  - D. He heard Goncalves tell her father she was going to keep the money, as she got into a light-colored [REDACTED] that had arrived as they completed the deal. He was unable to see who was in the [REDACTED] or provide additional detail about the [REDACTED].
2. On November 23, 2022, I interviewed [REDACTED] by phone regarding [REDACTED] [REDACTED] provider the following information:
- A. [REDACTED] was a transient subject who arrived at the facility on October 31, 2022 and stayed until November 3, 2022.
  - B. On the evening of November 3, 2022, [REDACTED] collected his personal items and left the facility in a minivan. [REDACTED] didn't know who the vehicle belonged to.
3. On November 23, 2022, I interviewed [REDACTED] by phone. [REDACTED] is the [REDACTED] for 1122 King Street Moscow, Idaho. [REDACTED] provided copies of the current and previous lease agreement, workorder requests, and an invoice for completed work. I forwarded the email and documents to FBI Tactical Specialist Maria Tyndall to be included in the case file. [REDACTED] also provided the following information:
- A. The lease listed Kaylee Goncalves, Madison Mogen, [REDACTED], Xana Kernodle, and [REDACTED] as the lessees of the residents from June 01, 2022 to May 31, 2022. The previous lease listed [REDACTED] Madison Mogen, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as occupants from June 9, 2021 to May 31, 2022.

### Narrative

B. The digital numerical keyless entry, located on the front door had [REDACTED] codes: 1: Programming, 2: Maintenance, 3: "Code A" (primary code given to occupants), and 4: "Code B" (used if an occupant was locked out by accident). Occupants could provide the door code to whoever they chose.

C. The keyless entry was maintained by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] of Moscow, Idaho. It was last serviced on October 19, 2020.

D. The keyless entry was not wifi or Bluetooth enabled and did not keep a log of entries.

4. On December 4, 2022, at about 3:05 p.m., I contacted [REDACTED] by phone and requested a DNA sample. [REDACTED] had been interviewed the previous day by ISP detectives, however, they had not collected a DNA sample. [REDACTED] agreed to meet me at the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED]t Moscow, Idaho to provide a DNA sample. At about 2:42 p.m., ISP Det. Matt Heinle and I met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] signed an ISP consent form before providing the sample. I provided [REDACTED] a new swab which he used to swab the inside of his cheek. At about 3:00 p.m., I processed the DNA sample at the Moscow Police Department (MPD) into evidence and transferred it to MPD Evidence Technician Tim Smallridge.
