On November 21, 2022, at approximately 1157 hours (hrs), I was asked by Captain Tyson Berrett to follow up on a possible lead in the 1122 King Road (Rd) homicide case. I was told a Mexican drug dealer with the moniker "C[REDACTED]" was possibly selling drugs to several fraternities and sororities on the University of Idaho campus. I told Captain Berrett I would contact several of my contacts to see if anyone knew of "C[REDACTED]".

At approximately 1204 hrs, I began contacting my fellow Quad Cities Drug Task Force (QCETF) detectives: Bret Dammon, Colby Martin and Bryson Aase. None of the detectives had heard of a "C[REDACTED]" selling cocaine in the Quad Cities.

At approximately 1211 hrs, I reached out to Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) Special Agent (SA) TJ Wihera out of the Spokane, Washington office reference "C[REDACTED]". SA Wihera hadn't heard of "C[REDACTED]", but said he would reach out to other agencies in the area about him.

I also spoke to C[REDACTED] E[REDACTED] at approximately 1313 hrs, and J[REDACTED] F[REDACTED] at approximately 1725 hrs. E[REDACTED] and F[REDACTED] said they never heard of a "C[REDACTED]" selling cocaine in the area. F[REDACTED] said he would contact me if he heard anything.

I also spoke with Branden DeMyer with Benton County Sheriff's Office in Washington at approximately 1625 hrs. Deputy DeMyer hadn't heard of "C[REDACTED]" but said he would contact his local detectives about the name and let me know if he

found out anything.

I will be waiting to see if any information can be found about "C[REDACTED]".
