Verizon Pen Warrant

On November 22, 2022, I applied for and was granted a pen warrant for any data associated with the phone number [REDACTED], which was linked to a possible witness, M [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. SA Nick Balance with the Federal Bureau of Investigations assisted in the production and service of the warrant.

On November 22, 2022, at approximately 2026 hours, the warrant was served via fax [REDACTED] and email to [REDACTED]@sf-notifications.com.

On November 22, 2022, SA Balance received notice the data requested pursuant to the warrant was available. The data files were downloaded to the forensic computers located in the secure forensic computer lab at the Moscow Police Department. The pen register trap and trace data were terminated on November 30, 2022.

M [REDACTED] was subsequently identified, located and interviewed as a witness by Cpl Brett Payne.

I completed the warrant return receipt and affidavit. These documents were sent to the Latah County Prosecutor's Office to be returned to the court. I also emailed a copy of the receipt to Verizon ([REDACTED]@sf-notifications.com), as this was the originating email address associated with the documents.
