3. Narrative

On November 29, 2022 I was tasked with having 5 vehicles from 1122 King Road moved to the City Shop located on North Van Buren. [REDACTED] towing was the only vehicle able to accommodate the towing of the vehicles. I watched [REDACTED] hook up to each vehicle and I then followed each vehicle from 1122 King Road to the City Shop.

On 11-29-22, I meet with D [REDACTED] A [REDACTED], FBI DFE agent out of Salt Lake City. I assisted Agent A [REDACTED] with removing the ECU from the Jeep Wrangler belonging to Ethan Chapin. After the ECU was removed I took possession of it and booked it into property.

On 11-30-22, Ofc. Aaron Morris was with Agent A [REDACTED] when he removed the ECU's from a Ford Explorer, belonging to Ethan Chapin, and a Chevrolet Cruz, belonging to Madison Mogen. Ofc. Morris took possession of the ECU's and I assisted him with booking them into property.

The ECU's were then shipped to Salt Lake City so the FBI could retrieve data from them. Once they were done they shipped the ECU's back to the PD.

I received a large package around December 22, 2022. I opened the package on 12-27-22 and found 3 ECU's in the box. We were told Agent A [REDACTED] would not be able to come back to Moscow for several weeks to reinstall the ECU's.

I contacted K [REDACTED] R [REDACTED], [REDACTED] Fleet supervisor. I asked R [REDACTED] if he and his mechanics could reinstall the ECU's and he told me he could. I provided him with the ECU's and they had them installed the same day.
