Interview with E [REDACTED] J [REDACTED]
On 12/2/22, the FBI tip line received a call from Ka Bar employee M [REDACTED] D [REDACTED], reference a I [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. M [REDACTED] had been contacted earlier on 12/1/22 by ISP Detectives Boone and Barrett due to his name being provided by Ka Bar on a list of people who had placed orders from Ka Bar. D [REDACTED] stated a call taker, E [REDACTED] J [REDACTED], from Ka Bar received a strange phone call from M [REDACTED] on 12/1/22. J [REDACTED] provided a written statement about what the conversation entailed.

J [REDACTED] stated she answered the call with the normal greetings directed by Ka Bar. M [REDACTED] interjected when she asked about his concerns about the call and stated "we will get to that later". J [REDACTED] went on to tell M [REDACTED] why the order was cancelled. M [REDACTED] stated he understood and never put his phone number on orders to prevent phone solicitation. M [REDACTED] then abruptly asked "what can you tell me about the two feds that showed up at my door today questioning my recent Ka Bar order?" J [REDACTED] stated she did not know what M [REDACTED] was talking about as she had no knowledge of the investigation. M [REDACTED] then stated something to the effect of "you know a Ka Bar sheath was left at the scene?" J [REDACTED] stated she did not know anything about the situation and asked M [REDACTED] if he wanted to complete his order. M [REDACTED] stated he was "a collector" and "had enough for now". He also added he "better hold off until things die down a little." M [REDACTED] then ended the phone call.

I spoke with Detectives Boone and Barrett on 12/2/22 and asked them if they mentioned the knife sheath. Both detectives stated they did not mention anything

about the sheath and that the conversation with M [REDACTED] was very routine. They did not record their conversation.

I called J [REDACTED] back on 12/13/22 and asked her to tell me about the call with M [REDACTED]. J [REDACTED] reiterated the contents of her statement. However, she stated M [REDACTED] told her "a Ka Bar sheath was left at the scene" and added M [REDACTED] told her one of the investigators told her that. Investigation into M [REDACTED] continues.
