### Narrative

1. From November 27 through December 1, 2022, Idaho State Police (ISP) Detective Sergeant T. Hopkins and I, ISP Detective D. Brown, met individually with four employees of [REDACTED] who were working the evening of November 12 into the morning of November 13, 2022. [REDACTED] worked the shift as a [REDACTED], while [REDACTED] all worked [REDACTED] shifts.

a. [REDACTED] stated the night was unremarkable and like most busy weekend nights at the bar. He did not recall any altercations or patrons who caught his interest.

b. [REDACTED] stated the night was unremarkable and like most busy weekend nights at the bar. He did not recall any altercations or patrons who caught his interest.

c. [REDACTED] stated the night was unremarkable and like most busy weekend nights at the bar. He did not recall any altercations or patrons who caught his interest. He knew Madison Mogen and Kaylee Goncalves as regulars at the bar and served them drinks that evening. [REDACTED] said they held normal conversations during the evening.

d. [REDACTED] stated the night was unremarkable and like most weekend nights at the bar. He believed one unknown man was thrown out of the bar for intoxication but was unaware any altercations or patrons who caught

his interest. He knew Madison Mogen, Kaylee Goncalves, and [REDACTED] as regulars at the bar and saw them at the bar that night.

2. The interviews were memorialized with handwritten notes and added to the case file.

3. On November 28, 2022, Detective Sergeant T. Hopkins and I met with [REDACTED], and her roommates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], at the [REDACTED] apartments, directly [REDACTED] of 1122 King Road. [REDACTED] related allegations of a stalking earlier in the school year involving [REDACTED]. Ultimately [REDACTED] a University of Idaho student at the time, was dismissed from the university and his fraternity. [REDACTED] was arrested by Moscow Police Department Officers on unrelated charges in September 2022. [REDACTED] was unaware of any actual stalking investigation conducted by law enforcement. The Moscow Police Department was familiar with [REDACTED] and he was believed to have been in the Boise area the weekend of November 12, 2022.

4. Detective Sergeant T. Hopkins and I passed on the information concerning [REDACTED] to FBI Special Agent T. Shirley at the Moscow Police Department. I entered the audio recording of the interview with [REDACTED] into evidence at the ISP District IV office in Jerome.

5. On December 2, 2022 ISP Detective T. Barrett and I met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] lived in [REDACTED] in Moscow, Idaho. [REDACTED] was the registered owner of a [REDACTED] bearing Idaho license plate [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] was parked in front of Apartment [REDACTED]. Surveillance video footage on November 13, retrieved from [REDACTED], captured a SUV type vehicle resembling a [REDACTED] leaving the parking lot east of [REDACTED] around 4:24 a.m., and a SUV type vehicle resembling a [REDACTED] return to the parking spot around 6:30 a.m.

a. [REDACTED] identified the [REDACTED] as hers. [REDACTED] said she worked overnights at [REDACTED] from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. [REDACTED] said she worked the night of November 12, and would have returned home the morning of November 13 between 6:30 and 7:00 a.m.

b. [REDACTED] said it was possible she parked in the lot east of [REDACTED] that morning, but that she usually parked in front of her apartment. [REDACTED] said it was possible she came home during her work shift to check on her cats, but she could not recall.

c. [REDACTED] knew 1122 King Road to be a party house. [REDACTED] recalled seeing two men standing outside the closed front door around 5:00 p.m. on November 12. [REDACTED] described the men on their phones, as if they had been turned away from the house.

6. I entered the audio recording of the interview with [REDACTED] into evidence at the ISP District IV office in Jerome.

7. On December 5, 2022, ISP Detective S. Knudsen and I met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at his parent's residence in Boise, Idaho. [REDACTED] related the following:

a. He was the Designated Driver for [REDACTED] fraternity members the weekend of November 12, 2022. Designated Driver duties are assigned on a weekly basis to freshman members. [REDACTED] was the only designated driver for the fraternity that day.

b. [REDACTED] was driving his black [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

c. Members requested rides from [REDACTED] via phone call or text messages. [REDACTED] members also communicated with one another over a group chat through the Group Me app.

d. [REDACTED] was a freshman member of [REDACTED]. He is from Boise ([REDACTED] [REDACTED]) and knew or knew of several other members from Boise prior to attending The University of Idaho.

e. [REDACTED] drove members and their friends to and from Moscow venues between approximately 1:30 p.m. on

November 12 and 2:00 a.m. on November 13. [REDACTED] estimated he have at least fifty rides to a variety of fraternity members and their friends during that time.

f. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] to be a former [REDACTED] member who had been kicked out of the fraternity for prior behaviors unknown to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had been told by upperclassmen that [REDACTED] was a low priority when requesting designated driver rides due to his status with the fraternity.

g. [REDACTED] had been told by upperclassmen to watch out for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] because they are known to be aggressive with the underclassmen.

h. [REDACTED] knew [REDACTED] as the former [REDACTED] of the fraternity. [REDACTED] lived in one of [REDACTED] in the fraternity house [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] a bouncer at the Corner Club, and [REDACTED] lived in the other two basement private rooms. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stayed in his room "ninety percent of the time."

i. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] was banned from The Corner Club for fighting.

j. [REDACTED] had taken [REDACTED] to gas stations on several occasions prior to the weekend of 11/12 to buy beer. [REDACTED] always bought Keystone Light.

k. [REDACTED] described both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as "mysterious people." He said they normally kept to themselves and did not talk with other people much. He did not like [REDACTED] but he liked [REDACTED]. He had heard stories of them fighting other people. He said fraternity members liked [REDACTED] but no one liked [REDACTED].

8. Specific to [REDACTED] interactions with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that weekend, [REDACTED] provided the following information and timeline:

a. At approximately 4:00 p.m. on November 12, [REDACTED] picked up [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] party and took them to Taco Bell and a gas station, the Tesoro off [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] bought Keystone Light beer at the gas station.

b. At approximately 4:30 p.m., [REDACTED] dropped [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] off near [REDACTED] residence, in the parking lot east of [REDACTED].

c. [REDACTED] picked [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] up near [REDACTED] residence and dropped them off at the [REDACTED] house on campus. [REDACTED] could not recall a time h was requested to pick them up and the request was not documented in text messages or his phone's call log. [REDACTED] never saw or heard from [REDACTED] again that night.

d. At approximately 7:30 p.m., [REDACTED] received a text from [REDACTED] to pick him up at the [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] ignored the text.

e. At approximately 9:30 p.m., [REDACTED] received another text from [REDACTED] to pick him up. [REDACTED] responded to the request, but he could not remember if he picked up [REDACTED] at his residence or at the fraternity house. [REDACTED] took him to The Corner Club. [REDACTED] never saw [REDACTED] again that night.

f. At approximately 12:30 a.m. on November 13, [REDACTED] responded to the group chat on the Group Me app, replying "No" to a question concerning flooding in a fraternity house bathroom.

g. At approximately 2:00 a.m., [REDACTED] returned to the fraternity house, went to the freshman sleeping porch and hung out with fellow freshmen and sorority girls for the remainder of the night.

h. At approximately 2:10 p.m., [REDACTED] posted on the group chat on the Group Me app, "Have we taken tabs on the fellas," referring to a headcount of fraternity members, upon news of the murders at 1122 King Road.

9. I photographed text messages, contact information, and group chat text strings on [REDACTED] phone. I entered the audio recording of the interview with [REDACTED] along with the aforementioned photographs into evidence at the ISP District IV office in Jerome.
