Forensic Extraction A

On December 13, 2022, I was requested to complete a forensic extraction on an iPhone provided by J. A. A. signed a Consent to Search form for the device and it was provided to me by ISP Detective Hugh Powell. The form has been uploaded to the case file.

The phone was powered on and I placed it into Airplane Mode to protect any potential evidence on the phone from being removed or remotely deleted. I took photos of the device and attached them to the case file. The phone required a passcode to access the data on the device. A. provided a passcode of " ".

In examining the iPhone, I first looked for identifiers, indicia of use and ownership. The device was black in color with a black colored case. The device was running iOS 15.1 and showed a model number of MGFF3LL/A. The name of the phone was "J. iPhone." The phone had a serial number of " " and IMEI # " ". It showed the user as " " with an email of " " @gmail.com. The phone number assigned to the phone was " ".

In continuing with my examination of the phone, I made the following changes to the phone's settings:
Auto-Lock was turned off.

These changes allow the phone and the forensic computer to communicate and share information properly. The phone was then connected to the forensic computers running the following forensic software tools:
Magnet Axiom version# 6.5.0.32778
Cellebrite UFED Physical Analyzer version# 7.57.1.9

This extraction was saved to a computer located in the secure computer forensic lab at the Moscow Police Department. An examination of the data will be conducted at my earliest convenience. The phone was returned to A.
