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Narrative:

Interview with Bryan Kohberger's neighbor, F█████ A█████ and A█████ A█████,

On December 30, 2022, at approximately 0630 hours, I stood by while a search warrant was served at ██████████, the residence of Bryan Kohberger. While on scene one of the neighbors A█████ A█████, who lived in the same building, stated her husband returned home and he might have additional information to add regarding Bryan. A█████ had been interviewed earlier in the day by several FBI agents, prior to F█████ returning home. Det. Mowery and I met with A█████ and F█████ A█████ in their apartment, ██████. I recorded the conversation with my phone and informed F█████ and A█████ I would be recording our conversation, which they were fine with.

A█████ said she had been speaking with F█████ about the questions she was asked, one questions being if she had ever seen Bryan with anyone else. F█████ told me they did remember a time when they returned home and said they saw Bryan sitting on the stairs, leading up to his apartment, next to a male. F█████ and A█████ described the male as having light brown skin, a sleeve tattoo on his left arm, wearing a sleeveless shirt and shorts. F█████ said the male was riding a dark color (blue or black) Harley type motorcycle. F█████ said the motorcycle was not a sport bike and was very loud. F█████ said he and A█████ both noticed Bryan and the male talking but said as they got closer both Bryan and the male stopped talking and looked at them. A█████ said Bryan acknowledged them and asked how it was going. A█████ said it seemed as if Bryan was acting overly nice. A█████ and F█████ said when they walked away, to their apartment, Bryan and the male were still silent and did not continue their conversation. F█████ said he saw the male get up and heard the motorcycle start but did not see him drive off. F█████ and A█████ said this was the only time they ever saw this person and or saw or heard the motorcycle.

F█████ and A█████ said Bryan seemed like a quiet person and they remembered meeting Bryan's dad, when Bryan moved in. F█████ said Bryan's dad was very talkative. F█████ and A█████ said Bryan's car was always clean and neat, even on rainy days. A█████ said Bryan would often park his car right in front of their bedroom window and they would notice the headlights when he came and went. F█████ and A█████ did not notice when and if Bryan changed the plates on his vehicle.

F█████ looked through his phone and thought, on the night of the murders, he

probably went to bed around midnight. F [REDACTED] did not remember seeing lights from Bryan's car and or knowing if Bryan was home or not.

F [REDACTED] mentioned, on another occasion, seeing Bryan return home around 0100 hours, and said he was wearing dark clothing, had on a dark colored backpack, and when they said hi to him he seemed pretty short with them. F [REDACTED] did not remember what day this occurred but said it was not the night of the murders. A [REDACTED] said she worked late hours often and would also see Bryan returning home around the same time she would, around 0100 to 0200 hours.

We thanked F [REDACTED] and A [REDACTED] for their time and told them to contact us if they remembered anything else. Our conversation with F [REDACTED] and A [REDACTED] was recorded and is booked on a DVD into MPD evidence.
