On January 6, 2023, at around 0710 hours I retrieved evidence from MPD Evidence Tech T [REDACTED] S [REDACTED]. I signed for the items and transported them to the Idaho State Police Forensic Lab in Meridian Idaho. Refer to Evidence Tech T [REDACTED] S [REDACTED] records for what specific items were transported. Once I arrived in Meridian I transferred the items from MPD to the ISP Intake receptionist. All items were signed for chain of custody.

I was then given several items the lab had tested and were able to be returned to MPD for storage. I signed for all items and completed the chain of custody paperwork on the bags.

Prior to coming back to Moscow I stopped at D [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] residence in Boise to retrieve the personal items which had been released to her [REDACTED] earlier in the week by accident. I packed these belongings into my vehicle and I returned to Moscow.

Once back in Moscow I booked all the evidence from the state lab back into property.

I left D [REDACTED] personal items locked in the vehicle I was driving and on 01-09-23 I transported these items to the City Shop and I placed them in a secure garage.

One item of note is as the items were being loaded into the vehicle I was driving, a Ford Fusion, we were able to get everything into the vehicle except a

small table. We attempted several times to get the table into the vehicle but it was not going to fit. D [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated they did not care if the table was returned so she had her husband break the table and place it in the vehicle.

On a 01-10-23 I told Ann Taylor, Defense Council for the suspect, about why and who broke the table.
